### Dzień 2 - Zadanie 1

#### Zapis nagrania

The mayor of Alicudi, a faraway Italian island, came up with a creative solution to deal with overpopulation of wild goats. He decided to offer them for adoption to anyone interested. Riccardo Gullo's idea came after a recent count found that there were six times more goats than people on the island, where only about 100 folks live. These goats used to be a fun part of the island, often seen wandering around the place, but their numbers have grown too much. They've started causing trouble, munching on plants, wrecking gardens, knocking down walls and sometimes even getting into people's homes. Instead of getting rid of the goats, which the mayor didn't want to do, he decided to give them away. He called it the "adopt a goat" plan. Anyone who wants one can ask for one, even if they're not farmers. The deadline to ask for a goat is April 10th. But there's a problem: capturing and moving the goats is not easy because the island is rocky and steep.

Despite the challenges, the idea is seen as a kind way to solve the problem. It's hoped that by finding new homes for the goats, the island can keep its balance and stay as beautiful as it has always been.
